"New Decision on the Application of Attorney-Client Privilege to Communications With In-House Counsel" by James Walker, Daniel Zinman and Hellen Park

February 11, 2009

A recent federal court decision, *Roth v. Aon Corp.*, Case No. 04 C 6835, 2008 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 106161 (N.D. Ill. Jan. 8, 2009) has provided a broader application of the attorney-client privilege to communications with in-house attorneys than have other courts. Our litigation partners James Walker and Daniel Zinman, with assistance from their colleague Hellen Park, have written a short memo examining this decision in the context of other decisions addressing similar privilege issues, and offer guidance on increasing the likelihood that communications with in-house counsel will be protected as privileged.
