"Strategies For Addressing The Eroding Attorney-Client Privilege For In-House Counsel" by Daniel Zinman

A recent federal district court decision, which significantly limits the application of the attorney-client privilege over electronic communications between in-house attorneys and their fellow employees, may signal an important and potentially worrisome trend. Daniel C. Zinman has written a short memo discussing this decision and offering a few key strategies for increasing the likelihood that emails involving in-house counsel will be protected as privileged.
